Book layout design, or "typesetting," is the art of creating a book's interior. It involves all of the decisions that influence the way readers experience the content of your printed book: fonts, spacing, the styling of chapter headings, margins, etc. A book layout designer will handle all these for you and produce a print format that lines up with the expectations of the readers of your genre. Many authors underestimate the importance of this step and fail to see how book layout design can actually mean the difference between a good and bad reading experience. A strong book interior is balanced and aesthetically pleasing in its choice of font, type size, line spacing, chapter headings, and margins — all of which should come together to form a perfect whole.
